To get to the Long Sault Conservation Area from the west, take Taunton Road east; turn north onto Regional Road 57 and travel to Regional Road 20 (Concession Road 9). Turn right onto Reg. Rd. 20 and travel east to Woodley Road. Turn left onto Woodley Road and follow to the main parking lot at the end.
