Central Lake Ontario Conservation would like to invite the public to explore with staff the Bowmanville/Westside Marshes Conservation Area in Clarington. Conservation staff will lead a hike through the trails on Tuesday, August 29th starting at 6:30pm from the area's parking lot. See a variety of waterfowl, osprey nesting platforms and learn about these two Provincially Significant Wetlands in the south end of Bowmanville.

This event is free to the public.

"Bowmanville/ Westside Marshes Conservation Area host 1.5 km of hard-surfaced trails with various interpretive signage and several nature viewing platforms," says Cathy Grant, Outreach Education Technician with Central Lake Ontario Conservation. "The Conservation Area was officially opened in late June and we want the public to enjoy this beautiful natural venue." The public are asked to wear appropriate footwear and binoculars would be an asset.
