

Booking Your Outdoor Education Program

1. Choose desired program(s).

4. A preplan package will be sent with suggested topics to cover before attending your program.
5. Ensure students are dressed properly. Improper dress may result in exclusion from program. This is especially important for winter programs
6. Bring signed green permit and payment with you.

\$ 6.00 per student per full day

(Please Note: No refunds for absent students.)

Classes with less than 17 students will be charged a base fee of \$50/ half day.

A \$25.00 cancellation fee will be charged to those schools who cancel programs for reasons other than weather.

Classes wanting to stay and do their own programming for the rest of the day will be charged a booking fee of \$20.00 in addition to program fees.

Appropriate Dress and Supervision

Teaching and learning beyond the blackboard can be enjoyable if you are prepared. Proper dress is extremely important in order to maintain enthusiasm and encourage learning.

Rubber boots and rain coats should be worn on wet days. When doing pond, stream, insects or survival game, rubber boots or old shoes are recommended. Students should always dress in layers. Winter boots, scarves, hats, mitts are required for winter programs.

In the case of Wilderness Survival Day; if students are not properly dressed they will not participate; No winter boots: No program.

Other items beneficial to bring include: first aid kit, non-aerosol bug repellent, sun screen. A reusable water container is a good idea as some areas have water but no cups are provided. Teachers are reminded that they are responsible for class discipline. Added parental supervision is required for water programs, wilderness survival day, orienteering, survival game and insect program.

Transportation:

Teachers must book their own transportation.
