Asian Long-Horned Beetle, Grass Carp, and Dog Strangling Vine are examples of just a few invasive species, which threaten the health of Ontario's forests, lakes and wetlands. Introduced from other regions of the world these invasive insects, plants and fish can have devastating environmental impacts.

This workshop will provide you with the most current information on these invaders and actions to date to prevent their spread.
