

# CLUES IN THE SNOW

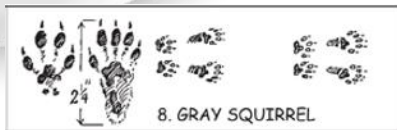


- What animals stay active all winter?

- Are the tracks old or fresh?

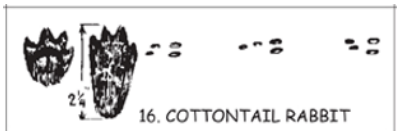

Tracks often end at a tree. Squirrel could be either gray or black.



Also look for round scat, and bark chewed off branches.



Front paw tracks look like baby handprints in the snow.



Tracks form one straight line.



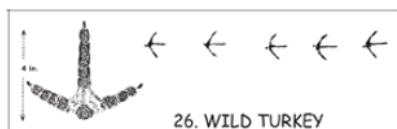
Tracks with a purpose (not all over the place like a dog's).



Found right beside the trail. Lots of urine markings.



Look like stars in the snow. These birds sleep in snowbanks!



Look like dinosaur tracks. Might be as large as your hand!
