

ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION

Planning your trip

2-3 weeks before your trip: Book the bus with the transportation department

2 weeks before your trip: Prepare parental permission forms for distribution.

Ensure adult supervision meets school requirements. <u>Stay-at-home children</u>

and pets are not permitted on field trips.

1 week before trip: Request cheque from administration.

Inform CLOCA staff of any health concerns, allergies, or special needs.

1 day before trip: Remind students of outing and proper dress.

Responsibilities

CLOCA Staff will provide:

- 1. On site instruction for specified time
- 2. Class set of equipment (maximum 30)
- 3. First Aid Equipment

Teachers are responsible for:

- 1. Booking the bus and canceling if necessary.
- 2. Arranging adult supervision
- 3. Ensuring proper dress
- 4. Class discipline and supervision

Suggested Dress	
Fall/Spring	Winter
Sunscreen	Hat, mittens, scarf
Bug Repellent	Windproof insulated jacket
Hat	Snow pants or wind proof pants
Long pants/long sleeved shirt	Thermal underwear
Rubber boots or old shoes – no sandals or flip flops	Waterproof, warm, low-heeled boots
Windproof jacket or rain gear	Extra socks and mittens
Extra socks and shoes	Sunscreen
